#### FIU NEW MUSIC ENSEMBLE

**About the ensemble:** The FIU New Music Ensemble specializes in the performance of contemporary chamber, experimental and electronic music with an emphasis on the music written over the last 40 years. The ensembles' instrumentation changes from semester to semester, allowing for the presentation of a variety of repertoire. The group performs a concert on campus every semester and from time to time in the community at festivals, museums, galleries, libraries, and at other universities. Since the ensemble forms an integral part of the composition program, works by student composers as well as works written expressly for the ensemble may be included on the concerts.

**Objectives:** The course is designed to give students experience with the performance and interpretation of art music written over the last 40 years with an emphasis on recent chamber and solo works. The ensemble is patterned after a professional ensemble giving students practical as well as educational experience.

**Requirements and Grading:** The basic requirement for admission into the ensemble is good musicianship and an open mind. Entrance into the ensemble is by audition and invitation except for composition majors, which must be in the ensemble for at least 2 semesters. The grading scale for this course is based on attendance and participation. Students are required to be present on time and prepared at all rehearsals in which a work that they are involved in is being rehearsed and at the scheduled concerts. A listing of rehearsal and concert times as well as the works to be rehearsed/presented will be distributed during the first week of class.

Compliance with the above requirements will result in the grade of A for the course. Failure to comply with any of the above will result in a lowering of the final grade as follows: first late arrival and/or unprepared at a rehearsal verbal warning, each late arrival and/or being unprepared at a rehearsal after the warning will result in a half letter grade reduction; each rehearsal missed will result in a full letter grade reduction. Please note a failing grade will be given to anyone missing concert(s); The only excuses accepted for missing rehearsals are documented medical and other similar excuses and/or excuses for professional commitments directly related to the student's major (these must be cleared ahead of time with the instructor). Attendance at concerts is mandatory (except for documented medical excuses only). Make up work is the student's responsibility.

Please note that this course is patterned after a professional chamber ensemble. As in a professional situation, performers are responsible for being on time and prepared. A professional attitude towards performance is also required.
